Retail Sales Index <p>Household indicator</p> <p>Loans from financial corporations to GDP are calculated from <u>Total outstanding amount of loans to household</u> divided by rolling 4-quarter sum of GDP</p> <p>Total outstanding amount of loans to household consists of overdrafts, general loans, non-negotiable bills and investments in from deposit-taking corporations and other financial corporations. Loans are denominated in domestic (Baht) currency and foreign currency. Accrued interest receivable is excluded.</p> <p>Rolling 4-quarter sum of GDP is the method of calculating GDP by accumulating the sum of gross domestic product at current prices of the past 4 quarters, starting from the reference quarter backwards.</p>
