Definition of terms used in the survey is as follows:</p> <p><b>Wage</b> is defined as the compensation, in cash or in kind, received by employees in exchange for their labour. Wages can be paid on a monthly, weekly, daily or hourly basis, project base or as a lump sum payment, excluding payments for overtime, bonuses and other welfare payments.</p> <p><b>Industry classification</b> is classified in accordance with the UN's International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) Revision 3 1990</p> <p>The survey is conducted simultaneously for all surveyed units nationwide during the 1<sup>st</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> of each month. Data are collected by NSO officers through interview with head or member of the household units participated in the survey. Data compilation is based on weighted average of sampled data, the details of which appear in the NSO's website (<a href="http://www.nso.go.th">www.nso.go.th</a>) under the topic "Labour Force Survey".</p>
