The data are compiled from the dataset group of all offices (including Bangkok International Banking Facility or BIBF).</p> <p><b>Peer Group Criteria</b></p> <p>The size of total asset of each full branch determines its peer group. The grouping criteria uses “market share” or the percentage proportion of a full branch’s total asset against the sum of total assets of all full branches. The three peer groups for full branches of foreign banks are the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Large Banks include full branches with market share of 7 % or above.</li> <li>2. Medium Banks include full branches with market share of 2 % and less than 7 %</li> <li>3. Small Banks include full branches with market share of less than 2 %</li> </ol>
Source of data	Foreign Bank Branches , Consolidated report : Data include IBF operation but exclude Non-Retail Banks
