Collection Method. The data are collected from the Trade and Economic Indices Bureau of the Office of The Permanent Secretary for The Ministry of Commerce within 15-day of the following month. Compilation The Laspeyres method was selected in compilation of consumer price index for Northeastern region. The set of weights are assigned to different group of products in order to compute the overall index. Each weight assigned to individual goods and services will be determined by the household expenditures in the year 2007. In addition, the compilation of the Core Consumer Price Index excludes products in the fresh food and energy sector.
