

# Odd Per Brekk

Mr. Brekk, a Norwegian national, joined the IMF in 1987 and has held a variety of senior positions in the European and the Asia and Pacific Department including mission chief to Indonesia and Lithuania, and Senior Resident Representative in Turkey and Russia. During 2005-2009, Mr. Brekk was the advisor to the First Deputy Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund. Before joining the IMF, Mr. Brekk worked as senior economist at the Bank of Norway.
