Martin Evans is Professor of Economics in Georgetown's Department of Economics. In the past he has held faculty positions at The University of Pennsylvania's Wharton School, New York University's Stern School of Business, the London School of Economics and the University of Michigan. In addition, he is a Research Economist at The National Bureau of Economic Research, and serves on the editorial board of several academic journals. He has spent time as a Visiting Scholar at the International Monetary Fund, the Bank of England, and the International Economics Section of the Economics Department at Princeton University. Professor Evans' research interests cover the areas of International Macroeconomics, Finance, and Time Series Econometrics. He is the author of "Exchange-Rate Dynamics" (Princeton), a recently published PhD - level textbook, and a large number of articles in academic journals.
