Mr. Giovanni Ganelli, an Italian national, is a senior economist in the IMF's Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific (OAP). He joined the IMF in 2003. Before being assigned to OAP in August 2012, he was based at the IMF's Headquarters in Washington DC, where he worked in the Fiscal Affairs, European and Institute for Capacity Development departments. During his IMF career he participated in several missions to various countries in Asia, Europe, and Africa. During 2010 he went on leave from the Fund for one year and worked for the World Bank in Cambodia, where he also taught at the Royal University of Phnom Penh. He is currently a member of the IMF team which carries out the annual Article IV consultation with Japan. He holds a PhD in Economics from the University of Warwick (UK). His research focuses on fiscal policy issues and, more recently, on structural reforms in Japan.
