Donald Kohn is a senior fellow in the economic studies program at the Brookings Institution. He was also appointed by the government of the United Kingdom to serve on its Financial Policy Committee. He is a 40-year veteran of the Federal Reserve System. He served as vice chairman of the Board from 2006-2010. Prior to taking office as a member of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve 2002, he was an adviser to the Board for Monetary Policy (2001-02), secretary of the Federal Open Market Committee (1987-2002), director of the Division of Monetary Affairs (1987-2001), and held several staff positions prior to that. He has also served as chairman of the Committee on the Global Financial System (CGFS), a central bank panel that monitors and examines broad issues related to financial markets and systems. His research interests center on monetary policy and financial regulation.
