He studied economics and applied econometrics at Monash University and the University of Melbourne. He has been with the MAS since 1992 and currently heads the EPG which formulates Singapore monetary policy and undertakes applied research on broader issues facing the domestic economy. Edward has strong interest in macroeconomic modeling and continues to be involved in developmental work on the suite of models at the MAS, which are used for policy analysis. He has also been engaged in other areas of economic policy work including in various inter-ministry work groups looking at structural challenges facing the Singapore economy. He served on the Board of the Singapore Competition Commission between 2005 and 2007.
