Young Kyung Suh is the Bank of Korea's Deputy Governor in charge of the Research and the Economic Statistics Department. Prior to this she worked in various divisions of the Bank, including the Research Department, the Economic Research Institute, the International Department and the Monetary Policy & Markets Department. Since the global financial crisis in 2008, in particular, she has played a leading role in conducting research for the establishment of a macro-prudential policy framework for financial stability in the foreign exchange sector, the formation of measures to promote capital flow stability, the development of effective monetary policy instruments and the coordination of monetary and macro-prudential policies. While serving as Director of Financial Markets Division from 2012, she contributed greatly to the carrying out of the duties of monetary and credit policy formulation and of achieving financial stability, through timely and accurate analyses of financial market risk factors for example, and implementation of the relevant policies. Deputy Governor Suh holds a PhD from George Washington University.
