The Value of Banknotes paid by the Bank of Thailand in August 2001

The Bank of Thailand (BOT) recently reported on the value of banknotes paid in August 2001 and the value of banknotes in circulation at the end of August 2001.

The BOT revealed that the value of banknotes paid in August 2001 was B104,549.60 million, increased by B1,529.60 million or 1.48 percent from the previous month, and increased by B15,899.21 million or 17.93 percent, compared to the same period last year.

The total value of banknotes in circulation at end-August 2001 was B435,481.41 million, a reduction of B1,378.60 million or 0.32 percent from the previous month. When compared to the same period last year, it was increased by B36,767.20 million or 9.22 percent. However, the value mentioned above excluded the denominations of 500000-baht, 60-baht, five-baht, and one-baht banknotes.
