Funds Transferred via BAHTNET System in June 2001

The Bank of Thailand (BOT) announced the funds transferred via BAHTNET system in June 2001. The total number of funds transferred via BAHTNET system in June 2001 was 62,144 transactions with the value of B5,737,101 million.

During June the number of transactions and the total value of funds transferred via BAHTNET system increased from May by 3.17 percent and 7.24 percent, respectively.

In June 2001, the values of funds transfer for the government securities trading, general funds transfer, and foreign exchange funds transfer increased by 46.45, 25.30, and 9.44 percent respectively. Whereas, the funds transfer for private securities trading totalled B48,839 million, decreased from the previous month by 38.93 percent. The funds transfer for non-resident baht account remained relatively stable.

BAHTNET system has been developed by the BOT for large-value funds transfer since 1995. The system is supposed to be beneficial to the financial institutions because it helps the funds transfer to be faster, safer, and it greatly reduces payment risk.
