Notification of the Bank of Thailand

Re: Special Holiday for Financial Institutions

1. Objective

The Cabinet's Resolution on 30 November 2010 has declared a special public holiday on 16 May 2011 in order to encourage family-oriented tourism.

To support the government policy and considering that this is not against our tradition, the Bank of Thailand (BOT) therefore has designated 16 May 2011 to be an additional holiday for financial institutions. Making this announcement well in advance should give businesses enough time to prepare and thus, there should not be material impact on financial system and the overall economy.

2. Statutory Authority

By virtue of the provision of section 37 of the Financial Institutions Business Act B.E.2551, the Bank of Thailand hereby announces financial institutions' special holiday.

3. Scope of Application

All financial institutions under the Financial Institutions Business Act B.E. 2551

4. Special Holiday

16 May 2011 has been declared a special holiday for Financial Institutions.

5. Effective Date

This notification is effective from the day after its publication in the Government Gazette.
